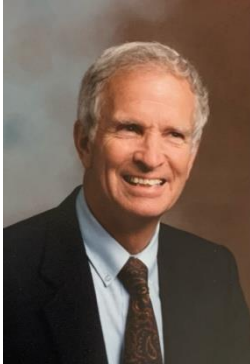

## Leonard Sargent Thomsen

June 27<sup>th</sup>, 1934- October 7<sup>th</sup>, 2020

“His life is a lasting gift to all of us!”

“It all began with a series of index cards, Len’s Rolodex, and lots of hand done, detailed work. Len felt very strongly that we needed to oversee the Deerwood Foundation in the *Deerwood way*- low key, organized, and friendly!” Foundation co-Founder, Denny O’Brien.



On September 12<sup>th</sup> a wonderful celebration of Len Thomsen’s life took place in the Deerwood chapel, on an absolutely perfect Squam day. Many poignant and powerful stories, readings, and hymns were shared by those closest to Len, the long-time camp Director and co-Founder of the Foundation. In fact, of the 75 years of Camp Deerwood’s existence, Len only missed four summers; he did so only because he was flying for the US Navy. He was an anchor to so many, and he insisted that Deerwood’s Mission of inclusion, fairness, and civility be lived at all times.

Len had a very full and impactful life. His extended family is truly the greatest lasting example of his incredible talents, his measured and modest manner, and his understanding of all the magical benefits that Deerwood gives to young and old alike. Many of us were fortunate recipients of his council, his passion and understanding of the natural world (and trying to minimize our impact on it), and his love of family. “He set a high bar. He wanted all of us to live our lives to their fullest and to be better people along the way.”

Hard work, attention to detail, follow through, commitment, accountability, and teaching by example were all attributes associated with Len. Anyone who had the pleasure of working with him, understood how important it was to take care of the little things. His collective memory of people, situations, trips, Toots Shor food orders, and birthdays was unique and important to making Deerwood the way it is. But he was not just a man with a noteworthy work ethic. Len was also described in his remembrances as playful, mischievous, adventurous, and a warm, caring, loyal, and fun father, husband, and friend. “Work hard. Play hard. Lead by example, and have fun doing it!”

Many had the pleasure of accompanying Len on the Rangeley Lakes canoe trip over the years. Here, he loved to teach birch bending, where you would climb tall, slender, young birch trees to the top and then hang off until the trees would bend, slowly bringing you safely back down to the ground. It was a blast, and because Len loved it, everyone was willing to try it. “He would boost our confidence, make us feel good about ourselves, and praise us!”

Len’s spirit will continue to live on in important and essential ways, including through the Deerwood Foundation, which was one of his many impactful initiatives.

The tributes to his remarkable life finished with this mantra we should all reflect upon- “Find adventure. Challenge yourself...and he will be there to catch us (like with the birch trees)!”

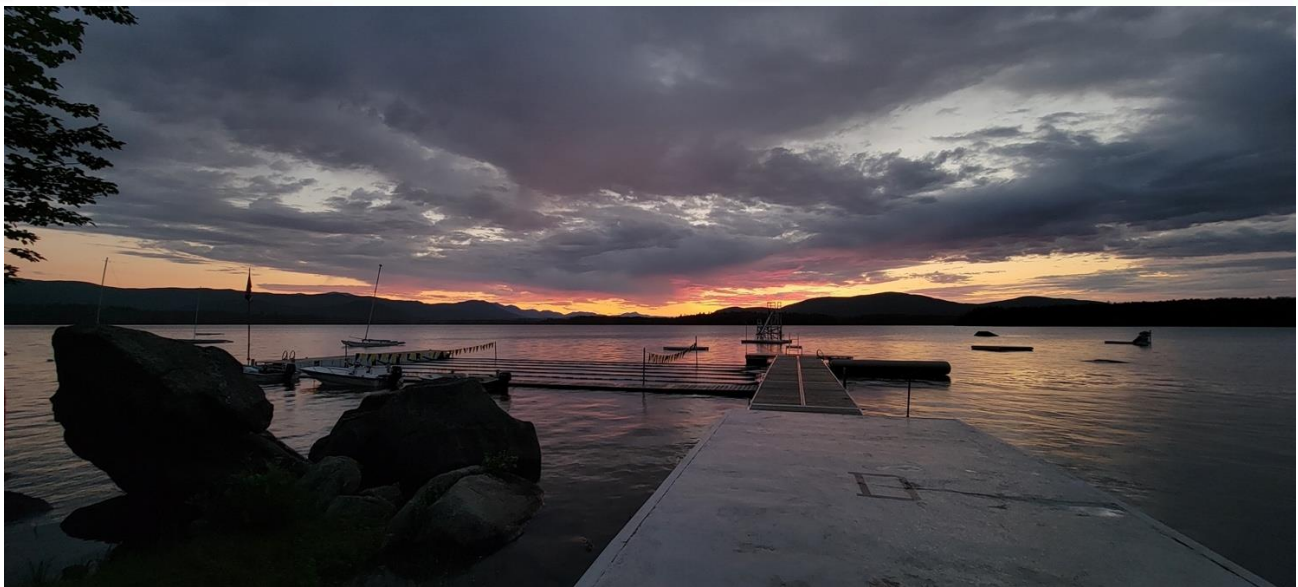
**From the out-going Executive Director, Biff Sutcliffe**

### Campership Report 2021

Preparing for the summer of 2021 was challenging for Camp and for the Foundation. Pete and Lorne worked hard throughout the fall, winter and spring to shape a workable Camp Deerwood experience for the 2021 season, given Covid and the fluid state guidelines for camps. Meanwhile the Foundation reached out to all of our families who were enrolled for the cancelled summer of 2020, and to our cooperating organizations, which are so important in helping us fulfill our diversity goals. Organizations and individual families wrestled with the wisdom of sending boys to camp and understandably had many questions and concerns.

When the numbers firmed up in late spring, the Foundation was able to give awards totaling \$96,550 to the following: 2 CITS, 3 full session campers, and 17 single session campers. Awards ranged from hundreds of dollars, to almost the total coverage of camp costs. While these numbers are consistent with recent years, our diversity initiative suffered from all of the uncertainties that surrounded families and camp.

The Foundation has a strong commitment to this initiative and looks to improve our efforts this coming summer. We are very grateful for the strong support that the Deerwood community has shown the Foundation over the years, enabling it to make a Deerwood experience available to so many boys each summer.



### Tree Talk Fellowships 2021

We are pleased to report that this year we awarded two Tree Talk Fellowships to two counselors. Both young men are attending college – one at Plymouth State University (NH) and the other at Wentworth Institute of Technology (MA). The Deerwood Foundation has established the Tree Talk Fellowship to support worthy counselors who might otherwise spend their summers working at jobs in which they could earn a higher income. By providing some scholarship aid to be realized when they matriculate in a post high school program, the Foundation hopes to promote greater diversity with our staff. Fellowship candidates must first apply for and secure a job offer from Camp Deerwood. After a contract is offered, the candidate will be encouraged to apply for a fellowship by writing a letter to the Executive Director to begin the application process. The funds of the award are sent directly to the institution to which the awardee is attending.



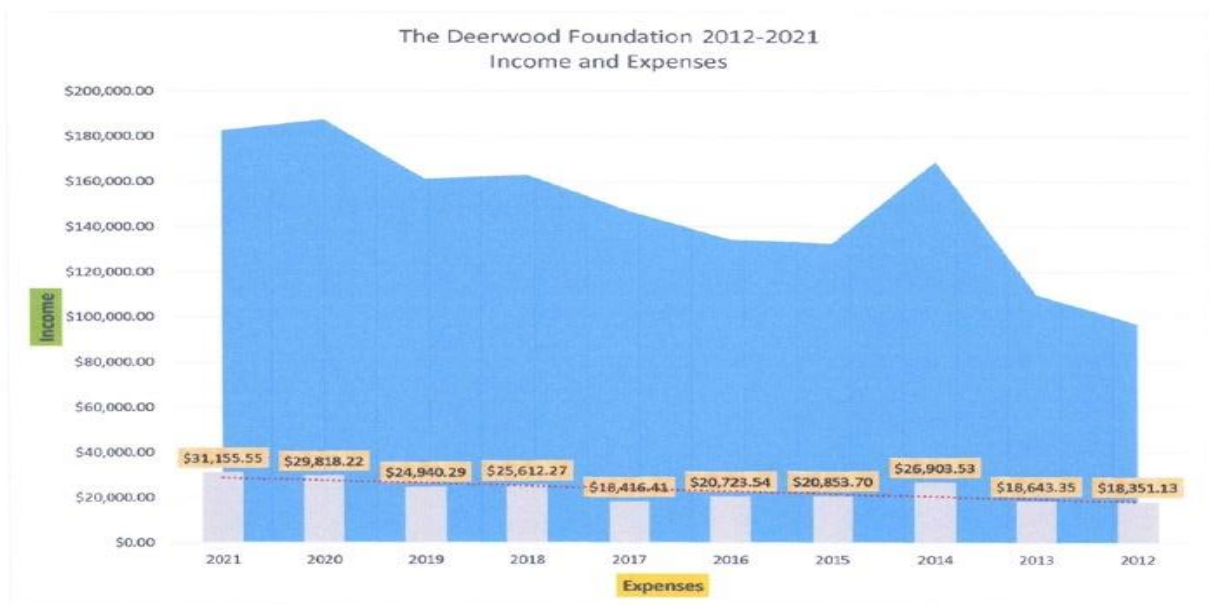
## 2020-2021 Fiscal Summary


