Campership/Scholarship Report Andy Smith



In 2024, we were gratified to welcome 27 boys to camp through the Scholarship program, 14 for the first session, 10 for the second session, and 3 for the entire season. The Foundation awarded \$150,355 in tuition costs, and also provided assistance for travel and accommodations totaling nearly \$4000 to help families make the journey to Deerwood. Individual awards ranged from a few hundred dollars to full tuitions. These young men gained immensely from their

experiences and gave so much by enriching the Deerwood community.

When you support the Foundation, you make it possible for us to promote the Scholarship Program by continuing to reach out to families in need, by strengthening current relationships with partner agencies that help us connect with prospective campers, and by seeking new agencies with whom we can ally to broaden our scope. We are so proud to partner with you in making the Scholarship Program thrive!

The Treasurer's Report From Deerwood Foundation Treasurer, Tom Riehl (since 2006)



The Deerwood Foundation was formed 30 years ago. In the first summer of 1995, we funded three camperships for \$6,000. Fast forward to the most recent summer, and the Foundation funded 29 camperships for over \$157,000. We are thrilled that we are able to support so many boys and their families.

Your generosity has allowed the Foundation to provide boys with a unique and enriching summer experience, while fostering personal responsibility and growth. These young men receive a summer of adventures and a lifetime of memories.

Thank you for your continued support. Over our 30 year history, the Deerwood Foundation has received 8,100 donations, with gifts totalling over \$2.2 million. This generosity has led to the funding of over 610+ camperships and Tree Talk scholarships.

The Foundation is well positioned to continue providing opportunities to those in need, in hopes of making the "Deerwood Experience" available to as many boys and young men as we can.

A few weeks ago, we sent out our annual end-of-summer mailing to the parents of campers from the summer of 2024. Included in the envelope was a personalized summary of each camper's experience in the form of an activity progress report, as well as a narrative comment written by each camper's Senior Counselor. As I read through these reports and comments, I was drawn to

those of the Foundation boys, and they filled me with the most rewarding feelings imaginable.

How proud these boys and their parents must have been when they read about all that they had accomplished around camp and contributed to their cabin groups. What also struck me was how these boys took advantage of the opportunities that they had to participate in things that they can't do at home. Each one of them went on an overnight trip. So many of them

channeled their inner creativity by completing art, shop, forge, and ceramics projects. They ventured well outside of their comfort zones to improve their swimming skills as well as to simply try new activities.

As each session came to a close last summer, the confidence that we were observing from these boys was indescribable. So many had become leaders, and a large number of them were looked to among their peers for leading roles in cabin skits and songs, Studio D, and drama productions, or simply helping to carry hilarious, memorable conversations at the table in Toots Shor. We cannot thank you all enough for helping to give these boys opportunities of a lifetime this past summer. It was so great to see them truly take advantage of those moments to grow.







The Deerwood Foundation was formed with the following charitable purposes:

Camper Scholarships -To provide financial assistance to allow boys between the ages of eight and fifteen years to attend Camp Deerwood. Such assistance will be provided without regard to race, religion or national origin of the recipient, and will allow boys to attend Camp Deerwood who would not otherwise be able to do so for financial reasons.

Counselor Fellowships - The Tree Talk Fellowship is a program where the Foundation can provide counselors with promising leadership potential, who may need extra support, to make a summer at Deerwood more financially feasible.

- To underwrite the travel and other expenses of counselors from foreign countries in order to enrich the experience of the campers at Camp Deerwood and to afford an opportunity for young people from foreign countries to learn about the American camping experience.
- To establish a permanent endowment fund to serve as a future source of support for the purposes of the Foundation.
- To receive unrestricted donations from individuals and corporations who wish to provide financial support to the Foundation to carry out its purposes.
